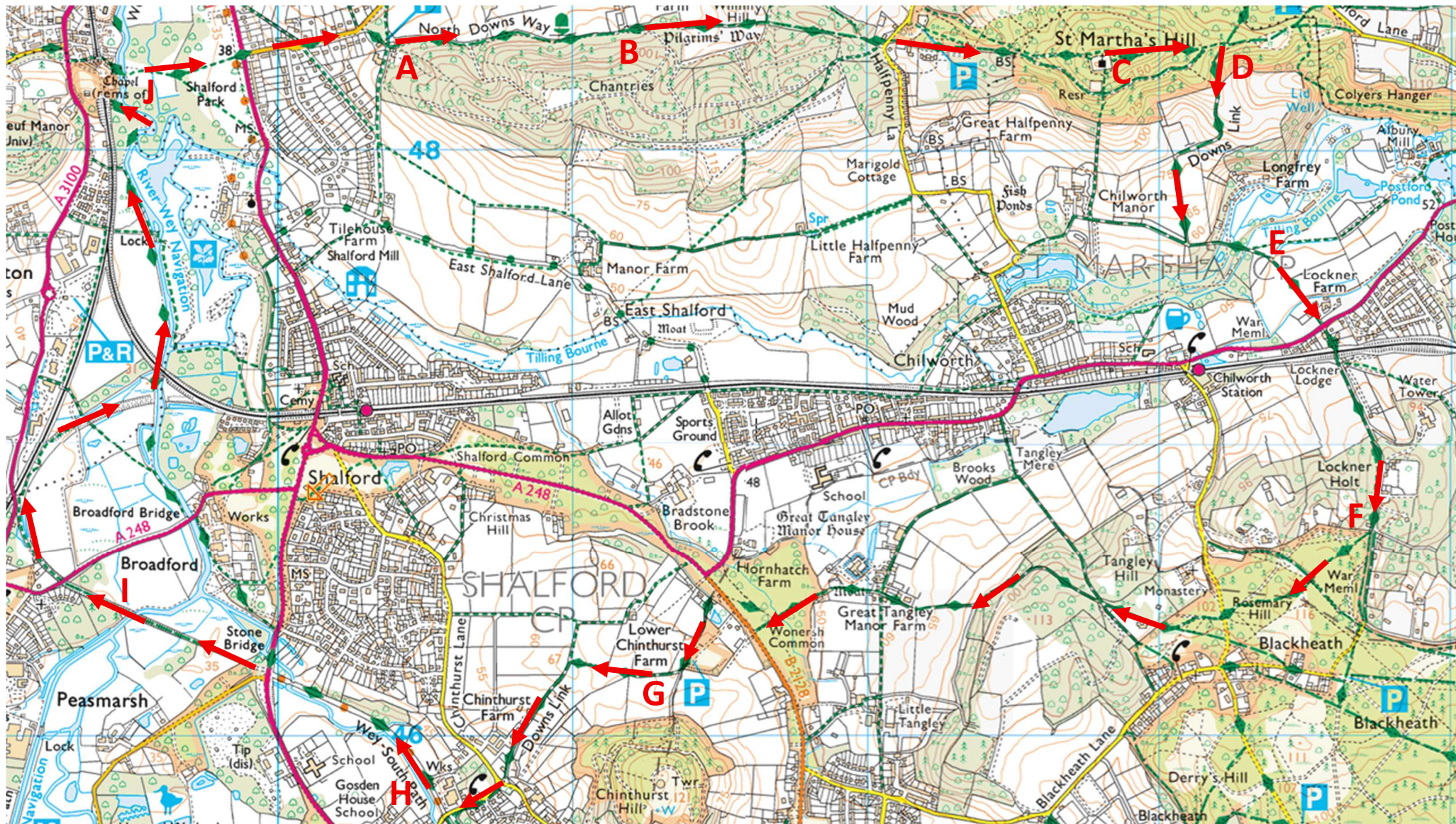


St Martha's Hill, Downs Link and River Wey circular walk



About 8 miles, with many undulations, 3 hours.

[A] – Chantry/Chantries car park, small and so can easily be full on Saturdays. On-street parking nearby.

[B] – Following the North Downs Way, uphill all the way, with the alternative way through Chantry Wood. Hog's Back to the left (north).

[C] – St Martha's Church generally open Saturdays. Lots of south-facing seating.

[D] – Start of the Down's Link path, 37 miles to Shoreham.

[E] – Over Tilling Bourne

[F] – Blackheath through to Great Tangle is a little confusing with few signs for the Downs Link, but with many footpaths and Bridleways.

[G] – For the energetic, there is an optional diversion up Chinthurst Hill (Google Chinthurst Hill for more information).

[H] – Join the old railway line, along which is the Wey and Arun Canal which enthusiasts hope to restore (from Shalford to Pallingham).

[I] – The old railway line crosses the Wey giving a choice of routes, either join the Wey here or follow the railway round the loop back to the river.

[J] – Bridge for the North Downs Way over the river. Following this takes you back to the car park.
